Christopher Newport University senior Chelsie Schweers has been named the 2011 *Women's DIII News* Player of the Year.

Schweers led the nation in scoring this season at all levels, scoring 25.9 points per game, and ranks second on the all-time Division III scoring list with more than 2,800 points. This season, she became the second player in NCAA history to hit 400 3-pointers, led the nation in 3-pointers per game and three-point field goal percentage. She earned Player of the Year honors in the USA South Conference.

"Chelsie had a terrific season statistically and she showed why she was one of the best in the nation," said *WDIIN* editor Gary Rubin. "She also helped her team reach the Final Four, which is quite an accomplishment. She is most deserving."

Schweers headlines the 2011 *WDIIN* All-American team, where she was joined on the first team by Jaci Daigneault of Amherst, Britta Peterson from Wisconsin Stevens Point, Utica's Jessica Berry, and Lebanon Valley senior Andrea Hoover.

WDIIN has named a Player of the Year every season since 1994.
